Allergies - You have hay fever and have become inexplicably sensitive to From Parish Nurse certain foods, there is a chance your dealing with an "oral" allergy syndrome

(OAS). That is symptoms caused by similar substances found in both pollen and some raw produce. The body's immune system recognizes and reacts to some of the same proteins in raw fruits, vegetables or nuts that are found in certain pollens. The main sign of OAS are swelling of the tongue, mouth, throat or lips, an itchy mouth or ears, or a scratchy throat directly after eating a raw fruit, vegetable or nut. Allergy proteins are often in the skin so peeling the offending fruit or vegetable may help. Sticking with produce that has been canned, baked or microwaved as cooking can deactivate the offending substance and the most obvious - don't eat the offending produce.
